Mission Statement

The Roads Program Quality Assurance Board of the Lehigh County Conservation District will approve projects that protect and enhance water quality by using environmentally sensitive practices to maintain roads in Lehigh County in order to reduce toxins and sediment-laden runoff from entering the streams. Top priority will be to assign to treat roads located in watersheds with higher quality and/or environmentally sensitive or critical areas.

Goals and Objectives

1. To reduce impacts to water quality.
2. To use only environmentally sensitive products approved by the state.
3. To consider the project's life span or long term impact.
4. To improve and enhance existing conditions.
5. Consider the cooperation and commitments of the applicant and/or participants.
6. To ensure work is completed in a manner that meets all State, Federal and Local regulations pertaining to the environment.
7. When and where possible, to encourage the use of native seed and plant materials.
